Performance Indicator: Demonstrate openness in trying new ideas, materials, methods, and approaches in making works of art and design. (VA:Cr2.1.6)	Learning Target: I can stay open minded and take risks while trying new materials, ideas, methods, and approaches in making art.
Performance Indicator: Explain environmental implications of conservation, care, and clean-up of art materials, tools, and equipment. (VA:Cr2.2.6)	Learning Target: I can explain the environmental impact of conserving, caring for, and cleaning up art materials, tools and equipment.

Pr4- Select, analyze and interpret artistic work for presentation.

Performance Indicator:

Analyze similarities and differences associated with preserving and presenting two-dimensional, three-dimensional, and digital artwork. (VA:Pr.4.1.6)

Learning Target:

I can compare and contrast the similarities and differences between preserving and presenting two-dimensional artwork, three-dimensional artwork, and digital artwork.

Pr5- Develop and refine artistic techniques and work for presentation.

Performance Indicator:

Individually or collaboratively, develop a visual plan for displaying works of art, analyzing exhibit space, the needs of the viewer, and the layout of the exhibit. (VA:Pr5.1.6)

Learning Target:

I can individually or collaboratively plan for displaying artwork while thinking about:

- display space,
- the needs of viewers, and
- layout of the exhibit.

Pr6- Convey meaning through the presentation of artistic work.

Performance Indicator:

Assess, explain, and provide evidence of how museums or other venues reflect history and values of a community. (VA:Pr6.1.6)

Learning Target:

I can evaluate and explain how museums and other venues represent history and the values of communities using evidence.



Respond (Re)

Re7- Perceive and analyze artistic work.

Performance Indicator:

Identify and interpret works of art or design that reveal how people live around the world and what they value. (VA:Re7.1.6)

Learning Target:

I can identify and interpret artworks that show how people around the world live and what they value.

Performance Indicator:

Analyze ways that visual components and cultural associations suggested by images influence ideas, emotions, and actions. (VA:Re7.2.6)

Learning Target:

I can draw conclusions about what I see in an artwork influence people's ideas, emotions, and actions.

Re8- Interpret intent and meaning in artistic work.

Performance Indicator:

Interpret art by distinguishing between relevant and non-relevant contextual information and analyzing subject matter, characteristics of form and structure, and use of media to identify ideas and mood conveyed. (VA:Re8.1.6)

Learning Targets:

I can interpret art by identifying background information that is important to my understanding of the artwork and information that is not.

I can interpret ideas and mood in an artwork by looking closely at:

- subject matter,
- form and structure, and
- use of media.

Re9- Apply criteria to evaluate artistic work.

Performance Indicator:

Develop and apply relevant criteria to evaluate a work of art. (VA:Re9.1.6)

Learning Target:

I can develop and apply criteria that helps me to make conclusions about whether a work of art is successful.

Connect (Cn)

Cn10- Synthesize and relate knowledge and personal experiences to make art.

Performance Indicator:

Generate a collection of ideas reflecting current interests and concerns that could be investigated in art-making. (VA:Cn10.1.6)

Learning Target:

I can brainstorm a collection of ideas based on current interests and concerns that could be explored in artmaking.

Cn11- Relate artistic ideas and works with societal, cultural, and historical context to deepen understanding.

Performance Indicator:

Analyze how art reflects changing times, traditions, resources, and cultural uses. (VA:Cn11.1.6)

Learning Target:

I can observe and explain the ways in which art can reflect changing times, traditions, and cultural uses.
